Boat Description

Natterjack is a well-cared for 40ft Colecraft cruiser stern. The stern deck is clean and functional with a well fitted cover. The BMC engine sits well within the engine compartment with ease of access all around.

Moving into the boat from the stern deck you come to an interesting space. Immediately you have storage port and starboard, with a set of solid steps. In this bedroom space you have a practical multipurpose layout with a fixed single/berth come seat and a counter space. The side of the counter drops down and inside is a roll up mattress that creates a full sized double bed. These also provide good storage spaces.

Moving through into the bathroom space you will find on the port side a wetroom style toilet and shower. On the starboard you will find a ceramic sink and storage unit.

Moving through into the light airy galley space you can see how the space has been well utilized to make the most of the 40' space. On the port side you have a Vanette valor LPG oven and 4 burner hob. Next to this under the worktop is an Electrolux 212 fridge. Also Port side you will see the sink and drainer unit along with a separate water tap with inline ceramic filter. Starboard side provides you with further worktop space and storage cupboard units.

The saloon offer another bright space with a well made L-shaped sofa with transforms into another 2 berths. This space also provides great storage. Under the gunwales starboard side there is some good shelving with 2 further cupboards port and starboard.

Through the bow doors you have a nice cratch space with a well fitted cover. Here you will also find 2 storage boxes.
