Revelation has been designed for family cruising. The 10-6-4 hull was built by Evans & Son in 1995 and fitted out by the present owner, the 1.8 Ford XLD engine and stern gear was fitted by Adelaide Marine. The unusual design of the hull is based upon a canal inspection launch, married with a semi-traditional style stern.

### **Boat Layout Description**

Revelation has been designed for family cruising. The 10-6-4 hull was built by Evans & Son in 1995. The 1.8 Ford XLD engine and stern gear was fitted by Adelaide Marine. The engine was professionally marinised by Thornycroft and being based upon the Ford Escort engine, spares are cheap and readily available. Separate engine and stern bilges are provided thus completely preventing any canal pollution risk. The unusual design of the hull is based upon a canal inspection launch, married with a semi-traditional style stern.

Under the rear deck are located; four domestic batteries, engine starter battery and 1.5kW 230V inverter which supplies an 800W microwave cooker in the galley. All the other boat electrics are 12V. Water central heating is provided by an Eberspacher D5W diesel fuel heater, or using the circulating pump alone, by means of a back boiler on the solid fuel Heron stove in the forward cabin. A hot water cylinder under the bed of the centre cabin provides domestic hot water.

The semi-traditional style stern incorporates a pedestal with the controls, gauges and electrical fuses, and a folding bench seat. Deck boards give access to the engine below.

The 11ft 9in open plan rear cabin offers a wardrobe and drawer storage with two bed-chairs. A small Victron sine wave inverter is fitted for charging mobile phones, laptops and the like.

Continuing through the boat, the 7ft 4in mid cabin offers a double berth with cupboard and drawer storage. The toilet waste storage tank and hot water cylinder are located beneath the bed.



The bathroom comprises a bath with shower over, washbasin and pump-out style toilet. The doors open to close off the side corridor for night-time privacy.


Next is the 6ft galley equipped with stainless steel sink and drainer, 4 burner gas hob, separate oven, 12v refrigerator, 800W microwave oven and storage cupboards. A side door and hatch provide ventilation.

The 8ft 5in forward saloon is a versatile space comprising a 6ft bench seat which can convert into either a double or two single berths. A free standing fold-up table enables easy dining for six. In the forward corner is situated a Heron sold fuel stove. Additional fold up chairs are included. A glazed door provides access to the forward deck.

Carbon dioxide and smoke alarms are fitted in the rear cabin and forward saloon.

The large 11ft 8in forward deck houses a raised area covering a large stainless steel water tank. The deck provides a spacious area for family meals and viewing the passing scenery. Transparent roll-up side screens protect the area from inclement weather during cruising. An overall cover is provided for when the boat is unoccupied.

The bow contains a large gas locker with two 13kg propane cylinders and a gas system bubble tester. A smaller locker is provided for water hoses.
