Morning Mist is a 2006 62' traditional stern narrowboat originally fitted out by Simpson Boats. Morning Mist has recently been through a complete refurbishment inside and out being brought back to its form glory by the current owner. Morning Mist has a contemporary feel throughout giving a cosy, warm, cottage feel with loads of light and bags of space. Every part of this vessel has been refurbished with new fixtures and fittings, new appliances and recent survey and blacking. This boat is ready to go either as a staycation style holiday boat or as plentiful continuous cruiser.

Boat Layout Description

Externally - Morning Mist has recently had a full body paintwork finished in Craftmaster graphite grey and black. Taken back to bare metal early 2020 and then hand finished giving a nice glossy exterior coat.

General Internal – The cabin space has been finished with T&G on the side panels and a solid hardwood floor throughout. Morning Mist is unusual in that it has 3 side hatches fitted (one in the Saloon, one in the dinette and one in the bedroom). These, when open, give great light and bring the outside in with the added benefit of air flow in the summer months.

Engine Room-Morning Mist is a Traditional stern starting here you step down into a large cockpit area which holds most of the boats systems including a Barrus Shire engine. With newly refurbished alternator and starter this engine, which is clean and tidy, has all the power you need for cruising the British Inland Waterways. This cockpit space gives you plenty of room to store your cruising bits and pieces and well.

Bedroom - Stepping down into the large bedroom space you have a large double bed with overhead lighting and storage. To the aft of the bedroom there is built in shelving, a shoe rack, built in drawer set and a small wardrobe. Add to this the large under bed drawer and storage space there really is room to keep everything together. The bedroom as one of the aforementioned side hatches as well as one of the 3 Houdini hatches allowing light in during the day and stargazing at night.



Bathroom room - Moving along the small portside corridor you come to a large full height storage cupboard in front of you. On the starboard side is the door to the bathroom. Stepping into this large space you will find a brand-new ceramic Jabsco macerating toilet. Also fitted is a ceramic sink with mixer tap and under sink storage and a full-sized bath with shower controls. The bathroom has 2 lights and an extractor fan.

Galley - Stepping into the galley you will notice that is nicely sectioned off from the dinette and the bedroom area. It has loads of space to move as well as ample cupboard and drawer storage space. Here you will notice the second of the Houdini hatches. The galley has been finished with a dark solid wood work top with stainless steel sink and drainer unit. The galley has little shelves and small cupboard to hide away you herbs and spices. The galley has been fitted with a new Thetford Capric Mk3 LPG oven and an Inlander 12v fridge with ice box. Before moving into the galley, at floor level, you will notice an additional cupboard with wine rack built it.

Dinette - Next, we come to the large dinette. This dinette will easily seat 4 adults and can be converted into another 2 berths. The new comfortable cushions fit nicely and will make a comfortable mattress when turned into a bed. The tabletop is made out of the sapele dark hardwood and contrasts nicely with the colour on the walls. The seating of the dinette provides a massive amount of storage underneath. Here you will find the second of the side hatches.

Saloon - The large Saloon is made for relaxing. Here there are 2 separate comfortable chairs looking over towards the large shelving unit, which has again been finished in the same sapele hard work. The shelving unit extends out into a large cupboard underneath the 12v TV which provides a large amount of storage. The saloon has an eco-friendly multi fuel stove finished in a vibrant red enamel paint which is sat on a slate hearth with a slate tiled surround. There is room for a log basket and the tools beside the fireplace. The fire will easily heat the space and add to the cozy ambience. The saloon also has the third side hatch and the final Houdini hatch. To finish before going out on the large bow deck you pass through a set of beautiful handmade sapele hardwood bow doors. Unlike many boats you will also notice the overhead sliding hatch allowing ease of access down in the Saloon without the need for ducking your head.

Morning Mist is a very lovely boat giving you a turn key boat ready for hitting the waterways.
