Daisy D is 2003 57' Josher style traditional stern narrowboat built by Les Wilson and fitted out by I Dixon. Daisy D has a good practical layout that would make a very comfortable leisure boat well suited for travelling the network.

Boat Description

Starting at the Bow, Daisy D has a large bow deck in the Josher style. On the starboard side the gunwale opens up to allow for easier access into the boat.

Stepping into the boat via the double bow doors you come into the saloon. Here you will notice the large windows bring in plenty of light. The cabin generally has been fitted with Oak veneer panelling and solid oak finishings. There is wood flooring in the Saloon and Galley, with a tiled showeroom and a carpeted bedroom.

Saloon – on the starboard side as you step into the boat there is a Bubble No 1 diesel stove, which also feeds 2 radiators and has a light blue tile surround. On the port side there is a storage cupboard which has the TV on top. The saloon also has a good sized 3-4 seater L-Shaped sofa which coverts into another 2 berth.

Between the Saloon and Galley there is a small space that could be used for a bistro style table, but could also accommodate some extra bedding of some description.

Galley – This space has all the necessary kitchen equipment including a washing machine. All the applicances are fitted on the portside including the stainless steel sink/drainer. The Oven has been built under with a 4 burner hob inlaid into the worktop. The galley on the starboard also has a very nice swan hatch.

Showeroom – This large space can be closed off from either end of the boat giving the width for it use. The shower is a square cubicle and is clean and tidy. There is also a ceramic handbasin inlaid to a pine style vanity unit. The toilet is a porta potti, giving loads of flexibility out on the cut.



Bedroom – The bedroom space comprised a ¾ mattress and base with a vast amount of storage underneath. When parked up, the bed base itself can be pulled wider, and with the aid of a mattress insert made into a full sized double. In the bedroom there is a floor to ceiling sized wardrobe with double doors, again providing a large amount of storage space.

Engine Room – The engine room is a typical traditional stern style with easy access to the engine, switch gear, invertors etc. The engine space itself is very clean, dry and tidy.
