Boat Description

Bilbo is a lovely boat that has been cared for from inside to out. The outside of Bilbo is in good shape with paint work still in order. The front and back covers are also in good shape and provide good protection from the elements.

The stern deck is a good size with storage locker on the port side and starboard. The engine boards are made from buffalo board giving good access to the engine bay. The engine itself is clean and tidy with no sign of oil or grease.

The sliding hatch and stairway configuration provide easy access down into the boat. Immediately on the portside you will find the controls cabinet. Here you will find all the switches and dial for the boats systems alongside a 3kW inverter. The starboard side you will find a useful storage cupboard.

The galley itself has loads of storage space and all the amenities. On the port side you will find the 12v fridge set of drawers, space for waste bin or potentially a washing machine and a large amount of worktop area. On the starboard side there are 4 large cupboards and the freestanding LGP double oven with hob. Again there is ample worktop space and a staineless steel sink and drainer.

The saloon is up next and straight away you will find this space is very large. Currently the space provides an L-Shaped sofa/dining table which can be converted into 2 further berths. The sofa also provides storage underneath. Directly opposite the sofa there is a nice large side hatch. Moving forward further there are 2 leather easy chairs, built in TV cabinet (port side) and a multifuel stove.

The showeroom is accessed via a practical sliding door. This room has a good sized shower cubicle, round ceramic sink with storage underneath and a vetus pump out toilet. There is also a towel rail and storage next to the shower.



Moving forward again to the bedroom you will notice a good sized double thanks to the bed extension. Under the bed again is more storage alongside a floor to ceiling wardrobe both port and starboard. The bedrooms have got porthole windows to provide further privacy.
