Boat Description

Tuppence has been loving taken care of by the current owners who, since their purchase in 2019, have upgraded some of the systems which now provide a full cosy, comfortable, cruising experience.

On the outside Tuppence is in good order with pram and cratch covers protecting deck space. The inside space has been finished with painted tongue and groove in a biscuit/cream colour which gives the space a light bright feel. On the roof is a set of recently installed solar panels giving you plenty of power whilst out on the cut.

The stern deck is a good size and large enough to have a couple of people outside. The pram cover is in good condition. The engine bay itself is dry and free from grease. The sole diesel engine has been well maintained and provides ample power for this little vessel. Also on the back deck you will find the gas cylinder and storage for all the cruising bits and pieces.

Stepping down into the boat you will find yourself in the bedroom. Here there is a good sized double which, underneath, has several compartments for storage. Under the bed you will also find the galvanic isolator, invertor and smart charger.

Moving forward you will find some floor to ceiling storage cupboards again providing a lot of storage.

Moving forward again you will find the shower room/toilet on the port side. This has been very well fitted with a nice sized shower finished with multipanelling, a ceramic vanity unit and Thetford cassette toilet. This space whilst small is still full of light and function.



The galley is opposite the shower and provides all the essentials. The hot water for Tuppence is provided by a wall mounted Morco LPG boiler giving you hot water as and when you need it. The galley also provide a small single oven, separate grill and a 2 burner hob. There is also a stainless steel sink and drainer and a small worktop area. To further enhance the galley space there is a wall mounted double cupboard unit. Finally in the galley is a good sized isotherm fridge with small icebox.

The saloon is next, this space is comfortable and cosy thanks to the layout provided. On the portside there is a long straight sofa, again with storage underneath, on the starboard side is a shorter straight sofa followed by an arrow solid fuel stove. This configuration of sofas gives you the flexibility for a single or transverse double.

Opening up the double bow doors you move into a decent sized cratch area considering the length of the boat. The cover is in good order and provides a usable outside space when the weather is a little off.
