Orinoco is a lovely 62' Traditional Stern narrowboat built by Colecraft and fitted out by Morse Marine in 1989. Orinoco is a 2 bedroom vessel with 5-6 berths with loads of storage and all the equipment needed for a extended cruise or for continuous cruising.

Boat Description

Orinoco was in 1989 by Colecraft in 10/6/4mm steel and fitted out by Morse Marine. Lined with Long run Parana pine T&G to ceiling and cabin sides and vertical to bulkheads, cord carpet to hull sides. The windows in Orinoco are double glazed. Interior headroom about 6'3". The exterior has been well maintained with the paint work reapplied and the signwriting freshened up.

The bow deck is a good size with cratch cover in place, here there are storage lockers/seats providing a nice practical space all year round.

Stepping down through the double bow doors you come into the Saloon. Immediately on the starboard side is the Morso Squirrel multi fuel stove. On the port side is a little TV/storage unit. The saloon as 2 comfortable easy chairs along with a coffee table and bookcase. Between the saloon and the galley is a little dining space formed from a character church bench and table, making this an ideal space for meal times or as a small but functional office space.

The Galley is a typical U shape with a good amount of below and wall mounted kitchen units providing all the necessary storage. There are also the key appliances in place. A shoreline 12v fridge, Vanette 7000 double under counter oven and a Vanette 4000 4 burner counter mounted hob. The galley also has a stainless-steel sink and mixer tap and is served by a large window port side and hatch on the starboard.

Moving aft from the galley you will see the main bedroom open up in front of you. First there is the large double wardrobe with an overhead shelf before moving to the double bed. There again is further storage under the bed.



Moving aft again you come into a corridor space, immediately on the port side you open door to the large shower room and toilet. You will notice there are 2 toilets, one pump out and one porta potti giving both options whilst cruising the networks. The shower is large with a shower curtain and stainless steel mixer taps. The space also has ample storage.

Next you come along into the back bedroom space. Again, you find another large bedroom as well as another side hatch. This bedroom comprises of 2 options. You can have it as the 3 x single bunk beds or as one large transverse double with a single bunk. Again, storage underneath the beds is available. Here you will also find the Alde boiler

Finally, we move into the engine room. Here you will find a very well-maintained space. It is clean and tidy, well laid out and not the typical oily diesel smell you may expect.

All in all Orinoco is a lovely boat retaining most of it original features, gives a nice cosy feel and provides many options and is ready to go for the new owner.
